Seth Rossetti Memorial Scholarship

Established in 2006, this memorial scholarship was created to honor Seth Rossetti. The purpose of this scholarship is to support one undergraduate student who is presently or who was for a significant part of his/her life the child of a single parent. This scholarship is available to all current FSU undergraduate students with a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average and all incoming FSU freshmen with a minimum 3.0 high school cumulative grade point average.

Applicants for the award must submit a pictorial collage of at least 10 but no more than 20 photographs that will communicate the student's sense of his or her personal identity and how he or she perceives the concept of diversity. Collages cannot exceed a size of 15" x 20". The collage will be accompanied by an essay of no more than two to four pages describing the collage and explaining their financial need. Essays must be typed and submitted using the standard U.S. 8 1/2" x 11" format, double-spaced, in 12-point font. One winner will receive a \$1000 scholarship (\$500 in Fall 2009 & \$500 in Spring 2010).
